

Homeowner Maintenance Responsibilities

Just like an automobile, there are many items in your home that require regular maintenance and/or inspection. The following table details many such items, and it is your responsibility as the homeowner to see that these tasks are performed. Failure to perform the tasks as indicated may void certain aspects of your home warranty.

Item Task Frequency

Furnace filters	clean or replace	every 2-3 months	
Water heater	drain 5-10 gallons	every 4 months	
Crawlspace	check entire area	Spring, Summer, Fall	
Water Connections	check under and	weekly for the 1st month, then twice a year	
(dishwasher, toilets,	behind, retighten as		
sinks)	necessary		
Sprinkler Heads	check & adjust	weekly during watering season	
Sprinkler Main Filter	remove & clean	start-up & mid-summer	
Sprinkler System	blow out water	October 1st	
Smoke Detectors	replace batteries	twice a year with daylight savings	
Trees and Shrubs	doop water	weekly for the 1st month, then	
Tiees and Siliubs	deep water	twice a year (Nov & March)	
Tree Trunks remove twine		12-18 months after planting	

Refrigerator/Icemaker & Clothes Washer

Leaks from the water connections of these appliances can result in extensive and costly damage to your home. Regardless of who performed the installation, we recommend that you treat these connections with a high level of concern. Hourly checks during the first day after installation would be time well-spent, then daily checks for the first week. Certainly do not install these appliances and then leave with the water turned on. The use of water alarms is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**.
